TAX PAYMENT DEADLINE

Please be advised that outstanding 2021 tax payments must be received at Municipal Office on or prior to December 31, 2021. After that date, all outstanding Property Taxes will be subject to 10% penalty, having the penalty applied January 1, 2022 (as per Bylaw No. 03-2021 Unpaid Taxes).

If you pay your taxes by bank teller or internet banking, please choose **COUNTY OF TWO HILLS** as the Payee.



Please ensure that you are on the approved snow plow list and that you have a proper County of Two Hills Snow Plow Flag out to have your driveway cleared.

REGIONAL LANDFILL HOLIDAY HOURS

Please be advised of Christmas Operating Hours:

The Regional Landfill and all Transfer Sites will be closed Saturday, December 25, 2021 for Christmas. The Myrnam Transfer Site will be open Tuesday, December 28, 2021. All Transfer Sites, except Myrnam and the Regional Landfill, will be open Saturday, January 1, 2022. Myrnam Transfer Site will be open Monday January 3, 2022.

HAMLET OF HAIRY HILL WASTE ISSUES

Please be advised of concerns raised with garbage bags being left exposed, having wildlife opening the same and littering the Hairy Hill Transfer Site. The Hamlet of Willingdon Transfer Site is scheduled for pick up on Thursdays, please plan disposal accordingly. Also, garbage bags are being filled in excess of 50 lbs. Please keep the weight of each bag less than 50 lbs for Operators.
