Hairy Hills Post Office

The CAO informed Council that the owner of Lot 5, Block 10, Plan 134HW Hairy Hill Post Office is requesting a reduction in property taxes Roll No. 1900.

In the past the County has reduced taxes for the Hairy Hill and Beauvallon Post Offices. This property has been assessed Fair Market Value for the Hamlet of Hairy Hill and Hamlet of Beauvallon.

Lac Sante Family Rec Society The CAO informed Council that the Lac Sante Family Recreational Society has submitted an Application for Property Tax Exemption, noting this application is required to be submitted prior to November 30 of the preceding year.

The Society requests that the County make an allowance, as the property was not purchased until March of 2014. It was also requested that this application be kept on file for the next three consecutive years.

Alberta Community Partnership The CAO informed Council that at the July 15, 2014 Council Meeting the Government of Alberta replaced the Regional Collaboration Program with the Alberta Community Partnership (ACP). In addition to the enhancement of the former Regional Collaboration component of the RCP, new funding opportunities have been created under the Community Partnership.

It was the consensus of Council that bridges be the County's first priority. Administration investigating this item, noted the same bridge must benefit both municipalities.

At the Joint Municipalities Meeting of July 16, 2014 the following items were placed on the table for discussion: Garage, Recreation Centre, Recycling, Broadband, Infrastructure and Trackhoe.

The next Joint Municipalities Meeting will be held on August 20, 2014 and each municipality is to bring their priorities forward.

Council having discussed this item; it was the consensus of Council that the County's priorities be: Infrastructure Studies, New Two Hills Recreation Centre, Broadband and Salt/Sand/Equipment Storage.

Hairy Hill Lagoon The CAO informed Council that the owner of NW 13-55-14-W4, where the Hairy Hill Lagoon is situated, has since passed away. The County of Two Hills has registered a caveat on the said property, showing an interest in the property.

B. Straty informed Council that 19 Firefighters from municipalities within the County of Two Hills qualified for provincial Service Medals from the Office of the Fire Commissioner. Having received these medals; it was the consensus of Council that the medal presentation be undertaken in conjunction with an Appreciation Barbeque for all Fire Members to be held at Jackfish Lake or Sandy Lake in late October of this year.

Mr. J. Haney, Municipal Planning reviewed the Land Use By-Law No. 5-2009 and Lac Sante Area Structure Plan By-Law No. 8-2009 regarding Country Residential and the Restricted Covenant of the Lac Sante Shores development.

Pt. SE 31-54-12-W4

The CAO placed the Pt. SE 31-54-12-W4 on the table for discussion, noting the landowner has agreed to all the terms and conditions of the consolidation and purchase of the County road, being all that portion of 44 Avenue as shown on Plan No. 2407 MC as shown on Plan 142 ____ and all that portion of the lane as shown on Plan No. 6491 MC running along the east boundary.

Amendment to Land Use By-Law

The CAO informed Council that the owner of W ½ SW 4-55-12-W4 is constructing a shop on Controlled Urban Development District (CUD), this development requiring an amendment to the Land Use By-Law No. 5-2009.

Mr. J. Haney, Municipal Planning recommended that Land Use By-Law No. 5-2009 be amended to add commercial use as a discretionary use under Controlled Urban Development District (CUD).
