# **Policy**

The Agricultural Fieldman or designate will inspect all request for stubble burning in order to reduce the unnecessary loss of soil organic matter and introduce any effective alternative.

## **Purpose**

To promote good soil conservation.

#### **Procedure**

- 1. All requests for burning stubble will be inspected and all possible economical alternatives will be discussed with the landowner.
- 2. Permits will only be issued by the ASB Fieldman or his designate as a last resource and only for those portions of the fields that have no other economical alternatives to handle the residue.
- 3. Emphasis will be put on soil type and soil organic matter to ensure that the soil will not be vulnerable to soil erosion.
- 4. Burning of alfalfa stubble (for seed disease control) will be dealt with in accordance with other grass residue permits.
