Policy

When issuing fire permits:

- a) The permit holder must advise the Fire Department as to the day he/she will be doing the burning.
- b) A fire guard (e.g. cultivating ploughing) must be established around the area which will be burnt. The fire must be attended to at all times.
- c) A copy of the fire permit issued shall be kept at the site of the fire.
- d) Permit shall be issued for no longer than a 10-day period, excepting at the discretion of the Fire Guardian.
- e) A fire permit for stubble burning may only be issued by the Agricultural Fieldman or his designate at their discretion. An inspection may take place before a permit is issued.
